Innovative Training for Luxury Footwear Manufacturing

Description

The project aims at strengthening the production of high-end and luxury footwear across Europe, at promoting the entrepreneurship of new talent designers and at developing a new generation of highly-skilled manufacturers, oriented to high-end and luxury products.

In consultation with companies leading such categories of products, the partners will assess and identify the knowledge, skills and capacities, which will be the basis for the creation and development of an innovative vocational training targeted to VET students, new talented designers, footwear workers and technicians, and new entrepreneurs in this sector.

Objectives

- To increase and reinforce the added value of European footwear;
- To update, review and disseminate the occupational profile “Technician on Tailor-Made Footwear Manufacturing” and the corresponding training content;
- To establish and provide training to bridge the skills gap on high quality and luxury footwear manufacturing, while enhancing the development of key-skills and competencies in the European footwear sector;
- To develop an innovative and flexible ICT based training on footwear manufacturing, entrepreneurship, marketing & commercialization, start-up business management, and others.

Expected outcomes

- An evidence based research on training needs/opportunities for luxury segment;
- A revision and update of the profile “Technician on Tailor-Made Footwear Manufacturing” and the corresponding training programme under principles and presuppositions of ECVET (the European Credit system for Vocational Educational and Training);
- A b-learning course, compiling all the information into e-learning format and workshops to be delivered by prepared trainers and coaches;
- The enhancement of employability of designers, modellers and entrepreneurs in the footwear sector.
